BOOK SALES OVERVIEW

TSC initiated and participated in weekly team conference calls with the Clyburn staff and Foundation.

TSC successfully booked and managed eleven (11) book signing events between October 27, 2014 and April 24, 2015 to diverse crowds.

TSC closes out this contract with eight (8) unconfirmed invitations pending and fifteen (15) interested parties. The eight unconfirmed contacts merely need confirmation from the congressman's scheduler. We have provided the contact information for follow-up on page 4 and 5 of this document.

TSC coordinated successful multimedia outreach for all booked events. In doing so, we significantly expanded the reach of the Author's social media footprint.
